Waste and Recycling

We have good options for getting rid of household waste in the containers.

- Since we do not have capacity for bulky waste, we kindly refer you to Holbæk Municipality's recycling centers.
- Please help the community by sorting the waste correctly and waiting for it to be emptied if a container is full.
- If something has ended up in the wrong place, you are very welcome to help put it in the right container.
- Cardboard boxes must be folded together so that there is the best possible space for everyone's waste.
- There is approved video surveillance on the site, and in the event of serious violations of the rules, the board may have to intervene.

We also offer a container for green garden waste. For the container to be used by everyone, only grass, hedge clippings and similar green waste may be placed in it; stones, gravel, soil, thick branches and special plants must be delivered to Jernløse Recycling Center.

Rules for Open Fires in the Garden



Only fire pits are allowed - use only clean and dry wood - Be considerate of neighbors - always have water ready - no fire in wind or drought - always turn off completely

Always follow regulations from police and municipality.

Camping Toilets

Important information: only empty at designated facilities.

Today, June 19, is a big day, we have now signed the contract for the transfer of Jos's estate share of the last plots in our association.

This means it is 100% our own association, and we should congratulate each other.

Together with both the former board and Ditte Jensen from Juridika, we have negotiated a really good deal.

The 2023 general meeting gave the current board the authority to negotiate the takeover within the framework of 500,000 DKK, and that has been achieved, with a positive result on our side.

Even though we have now bought up the last plots, we still have a good and healthy economy.
